TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you to our 2005 Sports Club International Youth Football Festivals. HOW TO GET THERE

Once in Great Yarmouth head towards the seafront. Once you have reached the seafront and you are looking out to sea turn left and follow along the esplanade to the very end where Seashore is situated on your left hand side.

ARRIVAL AT HAVEN

You may arrive at Haven, Seashore from 12:30pm onwards. All bars, restaurants and shops are open from this time. Keys are available from the club room from 16:00pm onwards. We ask all teams to please keep children out of the queues at this time. **Keys will only be given to the group leader who has signed the holiday booking form. No keys will be given to parents or children of any teams, Unless prior arrangements have been made by the group leader.**

MANAGERS MEETING

A managers meeting will take place at 19:30pm on the day of the arrival (29th April.) in the Malarky's Bar. At the meeting we will be running through any last minute details for the festival as well as giving each team their tour folder complete with football schedule, referee's and all staff present at the festival.

PRESENTATION NIGHT

This will take place on Sunday 1st May in the clubhouse at Seashore. Time of the presentation will be advised at the managers meeting. A Surprise football guest will be present at the presentation evening.

PHOTOGRAPHER

Sports Club International has an on-site photographer who will be taking team photo's at the football ground and at the presentation evening. You will be able to meet the photographer at the managers meeting where they will run through the services they offer.

ALCOHOL

NO CHILD IS ALLOWED TO PURCHASE OR CONSUME ALCOHOL AT THIS FOOTBALL FESTIVAL. ADULTS ARE NOT TO BUY ALCOHOL FOR ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18. ANY TEAM FOUND GUILTY OF THIS WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE HOLIDAY CENTRE FOLLOWING A MEETING WITH THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE. ANY TEAM FOUND GUILTY WILL BE REPORTED TO THEIR COUNTY F.A FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION.

ACCOMADATION QUERIES

Please ensure that you resolve all accommodation queries with SCI before the festival. Any queries regarding accommodation whilst at Seashore, please speak to reception.

BED LINEN AND TOWELS.

Bed linen is provided in all caravans and chalets. Towels however are not provided in any accommodation.

DEPARTURE

All accommodation must be vacated by 10am on Monday 2ND May. Please be aware that any damage to your accommodation will be invoiced directly to your club.

CHANGING AT PITCHES

Changing rooms, shower and toilet facilities are available at the pitches. Catering facilities are also available at the pitches.

SUPERVISION

We ask for your full co-operation on the question of supervision, all children in your party must be properly supervised at all times. Any cases of serious misconduct on the holiday park as well as the pitches will be reported to the tournament committee for further action to be taken against the offending club.

All children must be inside the entertainments complex after 8:30pm in the evening. Any children found outside the complex or caravans/chalets after 8:30pm, must be accompanied by a responsible adult over the age of 18.

No child will be allowed to leave the holiday centre unless accompanied by an adult. This is for everyone's safety and peace of mind.

No football boots are to be worn in the caravans/chalets at Seashore.

No players are to enter the complex at Seashore wearing their team football kit.

Team football kits are to only be worn going to and from the football pitches.

PLAYER IDENTIFICATION

Please complete the attached registration card with full details of players name and date of birth. Please attach a photo of each player, you do not have a league registration card for. Photo ID will be required for each player taking part in the festival. No player will be permitted to play without producing identification to the committee's satisfaction. Please bring all identification to the managers meeting on Friday 29th April for a registrations check.

Please enjoy yourselves during the festival, but please do have consideration for others! As always a great deal of planning has gone into the event together with our highly experienced team of organisers, we will be doing everything possible to make sure the football runs smoothly.
