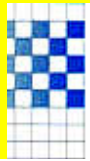

### Courses !!

Brinklow Football Club has secured funding for Football Association approved courses in the following areas and we are asking for our coaches, players and supporters to volunteer and attend one of the below listed courses on a first come first serve basis;

The FA Youth Award Introductory Module - a new course encouraging coaches to know as much about their young players as they do about the game. This one-day course provides an introduction to The FA Youth Award, which looks at how to coach young players as well as what to teach them.

Level One Certificate in Coaching Football - which is available throughout the country. It covers the organisation and delivery of safe and enjoyable coaching sessions for players. The course will provide practical drills to develop players' technical skills and is suited to those working with groups of young players.

Level Two Certificate in Coaching Football - provides a more in-depth understanding of coaching. The course also introduces new themes such as looking at different coaching styles, preparing for accidents and emergencies and players' nutritional needs.

Referee Courses - providing FA official referee qualification.

We are looking for volunteers as follows;

- FA Youth Award Introductory Module - 4 people (at least one female)
- Level 1 - 4 people at least one female)
- Level 2 – 2 people
- Referee Course – 2 people
